**Reception & Art Sale – Sunday, May 4, 1-3**

**Show Entries** **Bring up to three art works - Paintings, Drawings & Photographs** - in the theme of women and family. (This exhibit is not judged, so it doesn't have to be new work and can have previously been shown in other PSAA shows.) 3-d pieces & poetry/prose are welcome too. Mom and family are always in our heart and mind, especially in May – and our public reception and art sale happens the week before Mother's Day.

**Show Dates** **Drop off: Friday, March 28 from 10 am to noon** at PSAA Tuckerton Art Center, 140 E Main Street, Tuckerton. **Pick up: Friday, May 23 from 10 am to noon.**

**Reception/Sale Sunday, May 4 from 1-3, there will be a public reception, and artists are welcome to bring other artwork to sell if they choose.** (This will be an informal sale opportunity, for your prints, cards, scarfs, ceramics & other small works in any theme, in addition to the hanging gallery exhibit. You need to be present to handle your own small works sales.) The reception will be promoted and advertised, and a tent and signs at the front entrance will show there's an event happening, inviting the public to come. Reception fare and a small children's craft table will encourage visitors to linger.

**Fee** Complimentary; there is no entry fee and no commission will be withheld from any sales of your work.

**Requirements** Please follow normal gallery wire hanging requirements (not saw tooth or ring hangers) and have any 3-D art ready for display. It is understood that following the common practice of all PSAA exhibits, while care will be taken of your art while in the exhibit, artists are ultimately responsible for their own work. Neither PSAA nor Tuckerton Borough are responsible for loss or damage, however caused. Your work will also be displayed on the PSAA website and may be selected for event promotion, but this in no way compromises your copyright ownership. Participation in this show acknowledges your agreement with these standard national policies. You will handle any sale of your artwork (not PSAA), and your price and contact information will be on an exhibit guide so gallery visitors seeing your work on days other than the September sale day will know how to reach you.

**Please Note** Participation in this show does not conflict with other regularly scheduled PSAA exhibits coming up. Having your art in this show will not disqualify it from being in another PSAA exhibit. Please also be aware that art left uncollected for more than three months after a show comes down becomes PSAA's property. So please put the closing/pick-up date on your calendar.
