**Show Dates** **Drop off: Friday, August 1 from 10 am to noon** at PSAA Tuckerton Art Center, 140 E Main Street, Tuckerton. **Pick up: Friday, October 3, from 10 am to noon.**

**Sale/Reception** **Saturday, September 28 from 10-2:30, there will be a public art sale & reception.**

A tent out front will show there’s an event happening, inviting the public to come, and a children’s craft table will encourage families to linger and shop. PSAA has a limited number of tables, let us know if you want to reserve one, or just bring your own. Participating artists will be asked to contribute something to the public reception table.

**Fee** Complimentary; there is no entry fee and no commission will be withheld from sales, but you need to be at the September event to handle your own sales. PSAA will not be involved in selling your art – it’s all up to you.

**Requirements** Please follow normal wire hanging requirements for paintings (not saw tooth or ring hangers) and have your 3-D art ready for display. It is understood that following common practice of all PSAA exhibits, while care will be taken of the art while in the exhibit, artists are ultimately responsible for their own work. Neither PSAA nor Tuckerton Borough are responsible for loss or damage, however caused. Participation in this show acknowledges your agreement with this standard national policy. You will handle any sale of your artwork (not PSAA), and your price and contact information will be on an exhibit guide so gallery visitors seeing your work on days other than the September sale day will know how to reach you.

**Please Note** Participation in this show does not conflict with other regularly scheduled PSAA exhibits coming up. Having your art in this show will not disqualify it from being in another PSAA exhibit. Please also be aware that art left uncollected for more than three months after a show comes down becomes PSAA’s property. So please put the closing/pick-up date on your calendar.
